Summer Internships at the City of Beverly Hills: Internships (unpaid) available this summer within various departments at Beverly Hills City Hall. This is a 6-week internship (minimum of 15 hrs per week) throughout July and the first part of August. Certificates will be provided at the completion of the 6-week internship. All interns must enroll in the 5-week summer class (Office Occupations), which will be on Tuesday evenings (starting at 6p). Contact Mr. Hayne (Rm. 221) or Ms. Anspach in the Career Center for details.

Summer Internships at BH Superior Court: Internships (unpaid) available this summer at the BH Superior Court. All interns must enroll in the 5-week summer class (Office Occupations), which will be on Tuesday evenings (starting at 6p). Get school credits for working! If you are working this summer (job or internship) and want to get 5 credits, sign up for a summer 'work experience' class.
