Summer Internships at the City of Beverly Hills: Internships (unpaid) available this summer within various departments at City Hall. Applicants (at least 16 years old) must complete an online application and submit a writing sample about why you wish to intern at the City of BH, along with indicating their GPA. This is a 6-week internship (minimum of 15 hrs per week) throughout July and the first part of August. Certificates will be provided at the completion of the 6-week internship. All interns (at least 16 years old) must enroll in the 5-week summer class (Office Occupations), which will be on Tuesday evenings (starting at 6p). Get school credits for working! If you are working this summer (job or internship) and want to get 5 credits, sign up for a summer 'work experience' class. This class meets once a week (5-sessions), on Tuesdays from 6p – 9p. There are two work experience classes: 'Office Occupations' and 'Retail Marketing'. This is a great opportunity to not only pick up 5 credits, but to also learn about resumes, interviewing, cover letters, etc. You must be working throughout the 5-week period in order to sign up for the class.
