Summer Internships at the City of Beverly Hills: Internships (unpaid) available this summer within various departments at City Hall. Applicants (at least 16 years old) must complete an online application and submit a writing sample about why you wish to intern at the City of BH, along with indicating their GPA. This is a 6-week internship (minimum of 15 hrs per week) throughout July and the first part of August. Certificates will be provided at the completion of the 6-week internship. All interns must enroll in the 5-week summer class (Office Occupations), which will be on Tuesday evenings (starting at 6p). Contact Mr. Hayne (Rm. 221) for details.

Summer Internships at the BH Small Animal Hospital: Internships (unpaid) available this summer at the BHSAH. Good opportunity for students interested in a career as a veterinarian, or just being involved with a small animal hospital. Interns (at least juniors, starting this summer) must enroll in the 5-week summer class (Office Occupations), which will start on Tuesday, July 3rd, from 6p – 9p. Contact Mr. Hayne (Rm. 221) or Ms. Anspach in the Career Center for details.

Teacher's Aides needed for BHHS summer school: TA assignments available for summer school at BHHS. Summer school runs from 6/27 - 7/31. A minimum of 6 hours per week is required. The work schedule will be worked out between the teacher and student. All TAs must enroll in the 5-week summer class (Office Occupations), which will be on Tuesday evenings (starting at 6p).
