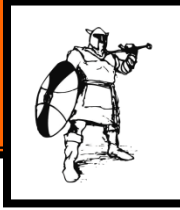

ATTENTION JUNIORS! Do you plan on applying to a Cal State (CSU) during your senior year? If so, you will want to participate in EAP, or Early Assessment Program. The EAP allow students, their teachers, their parents, and the CSU to know exactly how well prepared the 11th graders are for university-level work.

The two major subjects that comprise EAP testing are English Language Arts and Mathematics. Depending on your current math class, it will determine whether or not you are eligible to take the math portion.

If you are in: <i>English 5/6, Honors English 5/6, or AP Language</i> AND are in GRADE 11, You take the EAP Writing Test	If you are in: <i>English 5/6, Honors English 5/6, or AP Language</i> : You will answer 15 questions at the end of the CST English Language Arts, Grade 11 test	If you are in <i>IAT or AAT</i> -- You can answer 15 questions at the end of the CST Algebra II test
		If you are in <i>Math Analysis, Math Analysis Honors, or AP Calculus</i> -- You can answer 15 questions at the end of the CST Summative HS Math test
