Attention All Students Parking On Campus!!!

- You **must** park in your assigned spot. **PROHIBITED AREAS:**
 - Visitor and Staff Lots
 - Reserved spaces:

LOT C 223-228
LOT PE 260-270 and 273-277
- You **must** have your permit visible and posted in the REAR VIEW mirror (not flipped over **nor** behind another permit)
- **DID SOMEONE PARK IN YOUR SPOT?**
Report it to Campus Security or by email to mbuckley@bhusd.org When you report this, be sure to IDENTIFY the car in your spot (make, model, color) and the BHHS parking pass number (if it has one).

STUDENTS WITH PARKING PERMITS:

- Parking lot doors will be locked at the start of period 2.
