- You must have your permit visible and posted in the REAR VIEW mirror (not flipped over nor behind another permit)

Report it to Campus Security or by email to mbuckley@bhusd.org When you report this, be sure to IDENTIFY the car in your spot (make, model, color) and the BHHS parking pass number (if it has one).

STUDENTS WITH PARKING PERMITS: **NOTICE: You may NOT go to your cars during school hours starting Monday, January 5th.**

- Parking lot doors will be locked at the start of period 2.

Test Prep Workshops and Mock Exams

*For all workshops and mock exams, go to our school website for registration information or email Mrs. Chi at achi@bhUSD.org. All proceeds go directly to our PTSA.

ACT Workshop: Saturday, August 29, 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. in the EDC. This workshop is ideal for students preparing for the September ACT. \$40 per student.

Mock ACT: Sunday, August 30, 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the EDC. \$25 per student.

SAT Workshop: Saturday, September 19, 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. in the EDC. This workshop is ideal for students preparing for the October SAT, which is the current SAT (not the new SAT). \$40 per student.

Mock SAT (current SAT): Sunday, September 20, 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the EDC. \$25 per student.

Mock PSAT (new PSAT): Saturday, September 26, 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in the EDC.

PSAT Workshop (new PSAT): Saturday, October 10, 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the EDC.

This mock exam and workshop are ideal for Juniors and Sophomores taking the PSAT in October. You will first take the mock exam then get your results back at the workshop, then learn testing strategies to improve your scores. \$95 per student for both exam and workshop.

Another one for Friday: Teaching Assistant Openings for Fall 2015 – Come sign up if you are interested in being a TA for one of our amazing office or teaching staff members, please sign your name in the appropriate opening on the sign-up sheet that is outside the door of Room 292. To be eligible, you need to (1) have approval from your counselor, (2) a 3.0 or better GPA (unless waived by a particular teacher), not be enrolled as a student in that class, and (3) enroll in Work Experience that meets Period 2 (you come 2 times per week) or Work Experience that meets at Lunch (you come 1 time per week). Please note that some positions will also include a short interview (e.g., Front Office) process. Finally, it is important to remember that Work Experience is a class for which you will receive a grade so make sure you factor that into your decision.
