To be eligible, you need to (1) have approval from your counselor, (2) a 3.0 or better GPA (unless

waived by a particular teacher), not be enrolled as a student in that class, and (3) enroll in Work Experience that meets Period 2 (you come 2 times per week) or Work Experience that meets at Lunch (you come 1 time per week). Please note that some positions will also include a short interview (e.g., Front Office) process. Finally, it is important to remember that Work Experience is a class for which you will receive a grade so make sure you factor that into your decision. SAT Workshop: Saturday, September 19, 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. in the EDC. This workshop is ideal for students preparing for the October SAT, which is the current SAT (not the new SAT). \$40 per student.

Mock SAT (current SAT): Sunday, September 20, 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the EDC. \$25 per student.

Mock PSAT (new PSAT): Saturday, September 26, 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in the EDC.
