Another one for Friday: Teaching Assistant Openings for Fall 2015 – Come sign up if you are interested in being a TA for one of our amazing office or teaching staff members, please sign your name in the appropriate opening on the sign-up sheet that is outside the door of **Room 292**. To be eligible, you need to (1) have approval from your counselor, (2) a 3.0 or better GPA (unless waived by a particular teacher), not be enrolled as a student in that class, and (3) enroll in Work Experience that meets Period 2 (you come 2 times per week) or Work Experience that meets at Lunch (you come 1 time per week). Please note that some positions will also include a short interview (e.g., Front Office) process. Finally, it is important to remember that Work Experience is a class for which you will receive a grade so make sure you factor that into your decision.
