Students may **NOT** share calculators as well.

**BHHS will be offering American Sign Language for second semester!** We have an exciting new opportunity for students! During second semester, West LA college will be teaching a college level course for our students on our campus. The course will be American Sign Language I and will be offered after school (**approximately 3:15-5:15**) **2 days per week**. This is an amazing opportunity for our students to earn BOTH college and high school credit for a course. The course will be taught by a West LA College professor on the BHHS campus and students can earn students 10 high school credits in addition to 3 college credits upon successful completion. This class can be used to satisfy a year of the high school Foreign Language requirement. Any interested students should contact their counselors as soon as possible. Enrollment is limited.
