Beverly Hills High School Halloween Dress Guidelines

Halloween does happen to fall on a school day this year and some students may choose to come in costume on **Monday, October 31, 2016**. **Students who choose to dress up are expected to adhere to the following guidelines:**

1. Costume selection should not discriminate against any group regardless of race, religion, gender, sexual orientation, special needs, or grade in school.
2. Costumes should be positive and avoid anything that reflects violence, violent acts, drugs, or alcohol. The selection should be respectful of the fact that you are in school.
3. Weapons, facsimile weapons of any type are not allowed on school grounds for any reason on this day or any other.
4. Props, including but not limited to umbrellas, sticks, bats, horns, etc., are not acceptable.
5. Any costume must allow a student to sit in their seat at their regular school desk and fully participate in the teacher's classroom instruction/activities.
6. Full-face masks, covers, hoods, or head coverings are not permitted. Any costume that disguises or attempts to disguise identity is not allowed.

Students who are deemed to be in violation of these established guidelines will have a conversation with the building administration. The costume will be adjusted accordingly and parents will be contacted. Students who are unable to or refuse to comply will be sent home and recorded as 'Unexcused' for the remainder of the school day.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding in maintaining an orderly and safe learning environment.
