CSF Eligible Students If you received a notification through Jupiter Grades informing you that you qualify for membership in the California Scholarship Federation (CSF), please be sure to pay your membership dues by **Friday, September 23, 2016**. SF members are eligible for special awards upon graduation. Four semesters as a CSF member (grades 10 -12 with one semester in the senior year) result in a Lifetime Member certificate, gold cord, and a CSF pin. Students who are members of the CSF all six semesters, during grades 10-12, receive a Highest Honor certificate, gold cord, and a CSF pin.

CSF membership is not automatic, even if you are eligible. You must sign up and pay a \$6.00 membership fee each semester in which you qualify. Contact Laurie Edelstein to find out if you have missed payments for any previous semesters and **pick up a late payment form in House A** . An additional \$5.00 penalty will be added for all late payments, however, this will ensure that you receive the recognition you deserve at graduation.
