10th grade parents and students – This year's PSAT (preliminary/practice SAT) will be given on **Wednesday, October 19, 2016** here at BHHS. 10th graders must register and pay at the student store. **The cost is \$39 through Friday, September 9, 2016** and then the price will increase to \$49. I would highly recommend that your student participate in the PSAT test. As you may or may not know the SAT changed quite a bit last spring with the way it is formatted and the types of questions asked. This is a great opportunity to take the practice test and get specific results to see the areas where you are strong and the areas for growth before you start taking the real college SAT.
