**10<sup>th</sup> grade parents and students** – This year's PSAT (preliminary/practice SAT) will be given on **Wednesday, October 11, 2017** here at BHHS. 10<sup>th</sup> graders must register and pay at the student store. **The cost is \$49 through Friday, September 15, 2017** which will be the last day to purchase the PSAT. I would highly recommend that your student participate in the PSAT test. As you may or may not know the SAT changed quite a bit last spring with the way it is formatted and the types of questions asked. This is a great opportunity to take the practice test and get specific results to see the areas where you are strong and the areas for growth before you start taking the real college SAT.
